Walks start promptly at 10.30am

Wednesday, Jan 8 th	Meet in the Charles Ashmore Road car park entrance to Graves Park S8 8GJ which is on the left as you drive uphill on the A61 between Woodseats and Meadowhead. Free at the moment. 4 miles of suburban walking mainly on tarmac, but may be some mud. A few slopes and one hill around Graves park and historic Norton. Lunch at the end in the Rose Garden café if walkers wish to purchase or outside if bringing a packed lunch.
Tuesday, Jan 14 th	Meal. Joe and Dolores at the Grill, 36 Church Lane, Dore S17 3GS. 12.30 for 1pm. Main course plus pudding costs £17. Orders to Gil.
Wednesday, Jan 22 nd	Meet at Longshaw car park near Fox House map ref 267800. Free to NT members. Walk to Upper Burbage Bridge and back. Less than 5 miles. Afterwards at the Fox House pub.
Tuesday, Jan 28 th	Meet at Hundall Cricket club, Windmill Lane S18 4BQ for a 5 mile walk around Hundall.
Wednesday, Feb 5 th	Edginess at Curbar. Meet at NT car park on Curbar Edge – grid ref 260748. Circular walk from Curbar to Baslow via Baslow Edge. Some rough track, field walking and a steep hill at the end. Approx 4.5 miles.
Tuesday, Feb 11 th	Park near Derwentwater Arms alongside cricket pitch in Calver SK240 747, S32 3XQ. Walk along river to Bubnell and Baslow and back to Curbar. 4.5 – 5 miles
Wednesday, Feb 18 th	Meet by the old station in Bakewell, map ref 223690 , which adjoins the Monsal Trail- parking on street or in the car park(pay) . Walk through Manners Wood towards Haddon Hall and back along the river. Distance 5 miles.
Tuesday, Feb 25 th	Meet at Calton Lees car park SK258685, postcode DE45 1PH. The fee is currently £3 if there is someone on duty. Circular walk via Calton Pasture and Edensor.
Wednesday, March 4 th	Meet outside St Peter and Paul Church, Eckington, map ref 432798 for a walk via Renishaw , Chesterfield canal and River Rother. Distance 5 miles. There is good parking in the village especially Rectory Road.
Tuesday, March 10 th	Meet at the Wyming Brook car park(SK268858) which is on the right hand side just under a mile past the Redmires Road Sportsman immediately after a noticeable bend. Descend to Rivelin Dams and continue anti-clockwise back up to Redmires Dams circulating south of these back to the cars. Just less than 5

	miles with mostly good paths and steady gradients. Retire to the Sportsman at about 1.45 to meet non-walkers.
Wednesday, March 18th	Meet at the Hammer and Pincers car park on Ringinglow Road, S11 9RH. Walk via Wire Mill Dam, Mayfield valley and Whirlowdale area. Distance 4.5 miles, but can be longer or shorter depending on weather.
Tuesday, March 24th	Meet at Linacre Reservoirs car park S42 7JW. Access is from the B6050 Cutthorpe Road along Woodnock Lane. A walk of about 4.5 miles along the reservoirs and through woodland. Meet afterwards at the Peacock pub.
Wednesday, April 1st	Meet at Calton Lees car park (see walk on Feb 25 th for details of parking). Walk by the river, up to the tower and back through the fields.

Members of the group are invited to the De La Salle Club behind Beauchief Hall at 8pm on the second Wednesday of each month to socialise with other U3A and De La Salle members.
