Summary: Martin Harvey joined the team, following his successful participation in the Age Better SL "Story Catcher" project. The team made good use of the e-newsletter seeing an increase in numbers participating from the membership as well as responding more quickly to projects with tight deadlines. There is still however a great reliance upon members that the team already "know". The team did not proceed with either of the MOUs from 2019 due to safeguarding policy requirements in one case and the ending of the other due to Covid-19

Covid-19 meant that many projects were moved online, shelved, postponed or cancelled. The team met more frequently online and despite the challenges caused by the pandemic the team maintained and/or improved Su3a presence within the arts and education sectors in Sheffield. Led by MH and with the assistance of Elaine Burtoft and Camilla Jordan, we improved our webpage by introducing a more user friendly format along with much more information. This work is ongoing

Though there was an overall decline in the number of new projects we saw an increase in "partnered" RPs with both Sheffield Universities partnering with other universities both nationally (Manchester) and internationally (Israel and Sweden) around the effects of Covid-19 on older people.

The team agreed in principle that we would support the South Yorkshire Heritage List proposal led by Sheffield City Council on behalf of not only Su3a but also Barnsley and Rotherham u3as (Doncaster did not respond to the request); more details can be found under the Task List

The team continues to log completed projects with National Office. To date no Sheffield U3A money has been spent and the provisional offer of \pounds 150 from the EC is intact (note: this is not money we have received but money that we have been allocated for promotions, sponsorship etc.)
