

WHIRLOW BROOK GARDENING PROJECT.

To commemorate the 25th Anniversary of u3a Sheffield permission was granted in 2011 by Sheffield City Council to create a woodland garden within the grounds of Whirlow Brook Park. The area had to be cleared and re-planted. After many years of hard work, a handrail for access to the pond, two benches, and a solid oak shelter were erected. Whilst not a remembrance garden, donations from loved ones commemorating members who had died was spent on plants and shrubs and their names were entered in a Book of Remembrance. The history of Whirlow Brook Hall was researched, and descendants of the owners attended the opening of the impressive new oak shelter.
