

Port Sunlight & Liverpool Bay Cruise Saturday 21st June 2025

Last year following the successful visit to Port Sunlight, we were unable to do the Liverpool Bay Cruise due to an engineering problem. So we are running the trip again this year. It will give those who did the guided coach tour an opportunity to spend more time in the wonderful Lady Lever art gallery and for those who missed the excellent guided tour to go on it, followed by the Liverpool Bay Cruise.

This tour is open to all members, whether you have been before or not.

Arriving at Port SunLight, you will have the choice of a guided tour of the village in our coach or to do your own thing and wander round yourselves to discover the many unique aspects of this village. The coach tour lasts for 1 hour and then there is free time to go back to the places that were of interest.

The village is home to more than 900 Grade II listed buildings set in 130 acres of parkland and gardens. More than 30 different architects created the buildings, monuments and memorials we still see today, and



nearly every period of British architecture is represented



through revival design. The village is a good example of the aesthetic movement, which emphasised visual and sensual qualities of art and design, and the Arts and Crafts Movement, with its emphasis on traditional craftsmanship. Lever built Port Sunlight to house the workers at his soap factory, Lever Brothers, which eventually became the global giant, Unilever. The village represents one man's vision to provide industrial workers with decent, sanitary housing in a considered architectural and picturesque form.

A buffet lunch is included and will be available at The Bridge Inn from 12.45.



After lunch our coach will collect us from the pub and take us to Seacombe where we board our cruise ferry for a cruise of the Liverpool Bay. During the three-hour cruise, you'll enjoy incredible scenery and learn more about the fascinating history and geography of the River

Mersey and Liverpool Bay with expert commentary from a Blue Badge Guide. Our cruise offers incredible panoramic views of the river as you sail past Royal Seaforth Docks, Fort Perch Rock at New Brighton and along the Crosby Channel towards Blundell sands and Formby.

This special sightseeing cruise will also give you the chance to experience Anthony Gormley's spectacular Another Place art installation at Crosby Beach from the river, and enjoy incredible views of the 100 castiron life-sized figures spread across the foreshore, stretching out into the sea.



The cost of this day trip is £63 per person and includes the coach from and return to Sheffield, the guided coach tour of Port Sunlight, buffet lunch, the Liverpool Bay Cruise and all gratuities. To join us, please complete the application form and return as shown by the due date.
