

Burgandy & Dijon 16th – 22nd May 2026

We travel by Luxuria coach to our hotel in Dijon for our 4 night stay. En-route we stop overnight east of Paris and complete our journey to Dijon the following day.



Dijon is regarding as the gastronomic centre of France and has recently opened the 'International Food & Wine Centre' featuring the best of French gastronomy and wines. We will enjoy a guided tour of Dijon taking in the Romanesque and Gothic churches and Medieval streets of the Capital of Burgundy.

We visit the little known gem of Besancon, which is the capital of the



Franche-Conte region and home of Victor Hugo. The city straddles the River Doub that has shaped and saved the city over the centuries. Even Julius Caesar recognised the defensive qualities of the location and many remnants of the fortifications remain including the

incredible Military Citadel that sits above the city. We will enjoy lunch here at a local Brasserie.

One of the days will be dedicated to the wines of the region. We visit the town of Beaune, without doubt, the capital of the Burgundy. Here we visit the Hospice de Beaune, one of France's most prestigious monuments



with its flamboyant Gothics architecture. We have lunch at a local restaurant before going to the vineyards of Patriarche Pere et Fils. Here a sommelier guides us through the exceptional cellars with over 2 million bottles and introduces us to tasting up to 6 different wines.

On our way back to England we stop overnight at Auxerre with time to look around the stone and wood historic town centre, before returning to Sheffield the following day.



The Luxuria coach only has seating for 31. The seats are wide and comfortable with plenty of leg room. Like travelling business class on an airline but on a coach. There are drinks and snacks served on board and each seat has an entertainment screen.

This tour will cost £1300 per person sharing a double room plus £280 for single occupancy. The cost includes Luxuria coach travel from/to Sheffield, bed & breakfast each day, 2 lunches, 6 dinners, all gratuities (except hotel), visits as listed on the itinerary, wine tasting and a thoroughly good time.
