

The Royal Welsh Show Tues 21st July to Thurs 23rd July 2026

This delightful three-day tour offers a blend of history, culture and scenic charm. We will visit Hereford Cathedral and view the fascinating Mappa Mundi. This is one of the



world's most unique medieval maps made around the year 1300. It is made on a single sheet of vellum measuring 5'2" x 4'7" and shows the history, geography of the world as it was understood in Christian Europe at the time.

The highlight of the tour is a full day at The Royal Welsh Show, one of the countries great agricultural shows, showcasing the very best of

Wales and the UK. Set in the hills surrounding Builth Wells, The Royal Welsh Show provides something to interest everyone through its wide range of livestock classes, attracting more than 7,500 entries from across Wales, the UK



and the rest of Europe, as well as activities including forestry, horticulture, crafts, countryside sports, food and drink, trade stands and a 12-hour programme each day of exciting entertainment, attractions and displays.

During our return journey, we cruise the river Severn and take in the glorious sites, best seen while gently cruising along the water. Relax and take in the views as the world drifts by. You'll also be treated to an afternoon tea, the perfect way to



round off our day before returning to Sheffield.
